## **DRIVING DIRECTIONS:**

FROM THE CLUB AT HAMMOCK BEACH: Depart the Club on Ocean Crest Drive. Turn right (W) onto 16<sup>th</sup> Road, then left (S) onto Hammock Dunes Parkway. Travel 2.8 miles, continuing over the Hammock Dunes Bridge, then turn left (E) onto Palm Harbor Parkway. Travel 5 miles; Palm Harbor Parkway becomes Forest Grove Drive. Turn right (NW) onto Old Kings Road and travel 2.14 miles. Turn right (E) onto Aspen Way, then right (S) onto Sweetgum Lane. Arrive at Master Court and Registration Desk.

TOTAL DISTANCE: 11.54 miles. APPROXIMATE DRIVING TIME: 15 minutes.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:**

- **WHAT TYPE OF COURSE IS THE CONSERVATORY?** With meticulously maintained fairways and immaculate greens, this masterpiece provides tournament conditions every day. Newly opened in November 2006, this Tom Watson Signature course is highlighted by manmade waterfalls, babbling brooks and veneered field stone work. The course offers dramatic, undulating greens not commonly found on Florida golf courses and encompasses approximately 140 acres, making it about 40 acres larger than the average golf course. The signature hole is number 8, a picturesque island green. The finishing hole features an elevated tee box, presenting a breathtaking view of almost the entire course.
- **WHO IS THE COURSE DESIGNER?** Tom Watson, winner of eight major championships and five British Opens, designed The Conservatory. Known for his acute understanding of classic and linkstyle layouts, Tom Watson created The Conservatory to provide an impression similar to the many courses he has played throughout the United Kingdom.
- **HOW DIFFICULT IS THE CONSERVATORY?** The Conservatory is currently rated the longest and hardest golf course in Florida. However, The Conservatory offers six set of tees and yardages ranging from 5514 to 7776, providing an enjoyable, challenging experience to golfers of all skill levels.
- **DOES THE CONSERVATORY OFFER RENTAL CLUBS?** The Conservatory is pleased to offer our guests a selection of premium rental clubs from Titleist, Cobra and Taylor Made. Guests have the choice of men's and women's sets in right and left handed styles, both available with various shaft flex options.
- **DOES THE CONSERVATORY HAVE A GPS SYSTEM ON THE GOLF CARTS?** Yes, golf at The Conservatory is enhanced by the world's most advanced distance measuring technology – GPS by UpLink. Designed as a tool for the golfer, the UpLink system combines the tradition of the game with Global Position System (GPS) technology to significantly improve the overall golfing experience. As the golfer approaches each hole, the UpLink GPS system displays a graphical overview of the hole featuring distances to the pin, fairway hazards, landmarks, pro tips on how best to play each hole and an elapsed timer to monitor pace of play. As the cart nears the green, the system displays the current pin placement with distances to the front and back of the green and pin distances from the center of the green.
- **DOES THE CONSERVATORY OFFER GOLF INSTRUCTION?** Golf instruction is available from The Conservatory's staff of PGA Professionals for private (1 golfer), semi-private (2-4 golfers) and group lessons (5+ golfers). Rates for private lessons with our Director of Golf or Head Golf Professional are \$100 per hour for members and \$125 per hour for guests; or \$75 per hour for members and \$100 per hour for guests, with any one of our Assistant Golf Professionals.
