Hammock Beach<sup>SM</sup> Resort established a “**greenteam**” at the beginning of 2008 in an effort to become more environmentally responsible. This team has been committed to implementing and monitoring strategies to improve the resort's ecological footprint. Their goals are continually expanding.

Hammock Beach<sup>SM</sup> Resort recycles paper, newsprint, cardboard, magazines, glass, aluminum, plastics, cooking oil and other materials on a regular basis. Offices, Recreation areas, and Food & Beverage outlets are equipped with recycling receptacles. Sensitive papers are shredded, then recycled. Toner and ink cartridges are sent back to the manufacturer to be recycled.

### **Green Team's Mission Statement:**

To initiate and implement a comprehensive Recycling & Conservation Program through ongoing awareness and education to our employees, members, owners, and guests in our attempt to become a more Green Resort.

- Currently, guests' recyclables are picked up upon request. Starting May 2010 a recycling program will be available in most guest rooms.
- Every guest room has the "Linen and Towel Reuse Program" in place.
- The Fitness Center and Spa utilize reusable water bottles and filtered water, in addition to recycling receptacles for disposable water bottles. The Locker Rooms' showers dispense shampoo, conditioner, and bath gel from large containers, rather than individual bottles.
- Toiletries used throughout the resort are produced in an environmentally-friendly, cruelty-free, and socially-conscious manner.
- Partially used shampoo, conditioner, and lotion bottles are donated to Palm Coast's local Kiwanis Club, which distributes the toiletries to multiple charities and shelters. Partially used toilet paper rolls are donated to a local shelter and troops in Afghanistan.
- Hammock Beach<sup>SM</sup> Resort's Green Team is community partners with Flagler Palm Coast High School's Shoots and Roots program. The team donated various materials to the students, as well as spoke to them about the importance of respecting our environment while in the workplace.
- The team organizes multiple beach cleanups involving members and employees, who cleared the shoreline of debris, trash, and recyclables.
- Newspapers and used rags are donated to local art classes and animal shelters.
- Outdoor lights are on timers.
- Golf courses use reclaimed water for irrigation.
- Employees collected soda-pop tabs over several months, and the team donated them to the Ronald McDonald House Charities.
- The Spa offers a signature La Florida Poultice Massage, which features all organically grown ingredients, including white cinnamon, lavender, orange peel, and ginger. The poultice balls, wrapped in natural muslin, are reusable and given to guests to take home.
- Hammock Beach<sup>SM</sup> Resort's Housekeeping department uses EcoLab cleaning products, which are environmentally friendly.
- Hammock Beach<sup>SM</sup> Resort is committed to "Green Meetings" by providing conference attendees with:
  - Individual temperature control in meeting rooms.
  - Condiments served in bulk.
  - Memo pads made from recycled paper, and trash bags made from recycled materials.
  - Recycled printing paper upon request.
- The team also educates and leads their fellow associates on greener practices, such as printing on both sides of paper, making scratch pads, turning off lights, hibernating computers, and more.
- Hammock Beach<sup>SM</sup> Resort has submitted its application to the Florida Green Lodging Association in anticipation of acceptance and participation.
