

NON-SMOKING RESORT

In accordance with Florida law and for the comfort of all our Members and Guests, smoking is permitted in designated outside areas only.

POOL POLICY

Outside food and beverage may not be brought into the pool areas. Guests leaving the pool or beach areas for over 30 minutes must relinquish lounges and chairs by removing all towels and personal belongings. Saving lounges or chairs for persons absent from the pool areas is prohibited. Children 12 years and younger must be supervised by an adult at all times. Children under 3 years must wear disposable swim pants before entering all pools. Disposable swim pants are provided complimentary by our pool attendant staff.

SERVICE CHARGES

In an effort to provide our guests with an exceptional resort experience, Hammock Beach Resort has in place a no cash tipping policy. Service charges are built into, and collected for, various services and activities such as lodging, golf, recreation and food and beverage.

Each and every member of our service personnel team is committed to providing you with the very best in personal service. If you feel that one of our team members has done an exceptional job and exceeded your expectations, please mention it to a member of our management team.

We encourage all our guests to please share your feedback with us. Throughout the resort, you will have access to comment cards. DRESS POLICY

HAMMOCK BEACH RESORT DRESS CODE

Proper resort casual attire is required when enjoying resort amenities. Shirts or cover-ups and shoes must be worn in and around the resort. Swimwear may only be worn in the pool areas. Members and Guests should choose to dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the setting of Hammock Beach and its facilities.

MEN

Collared shirts, dress collarless shirts or mock-neck shirts with sleeves, slacks or Bermuda-length golf shorts and shoes.

WOMEN

Dresses, shirts, slacks, Bermuda-length shorts with a golf shirt or blouse and shoes.

GOLF AND CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE

Proper golf attire is required. Please, no tank tops, T-shirts, sweat pants, warm-up suits or denim. Only soft-spiked golf shoes may be worn on the golf courses. Smoking is prohibited inside any public building by Florida law.

TENNIS DRESS CODE

Women must wear either a tennis skirt or shorts for their court times and a shirt at all times. Beach tanks, however, are not permitted. Men must wear shorts and shirts at all times; sleeveless shirts are permitted, but not cut-offs. Proper flat-soled shoes are required; no running or cross-trainers. Improper shoes will damage the courts and make for greater risk of ankle injuries. Should you have questions about the proper attire, please contact the Tennis Shop.

DELFINOS AND ATLANTIC GRILLE DRESS CODE

Resort casual attire. Sport coat for men preferred in the evening. No hats, visors, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, cut-off shorts, flip-flops or bathing suits are permitted.

FANTASY POOL COMPLEX AND INDOOR POOL PAVILION DRESS CODE

Modest Resort Casual attire is requested at the Fantasy Pool Complex and Indoor Pool Pavilion. Bathing suits must be worn at all times while in or around the pool. Please no thong bathing suits as children are present in these areas.

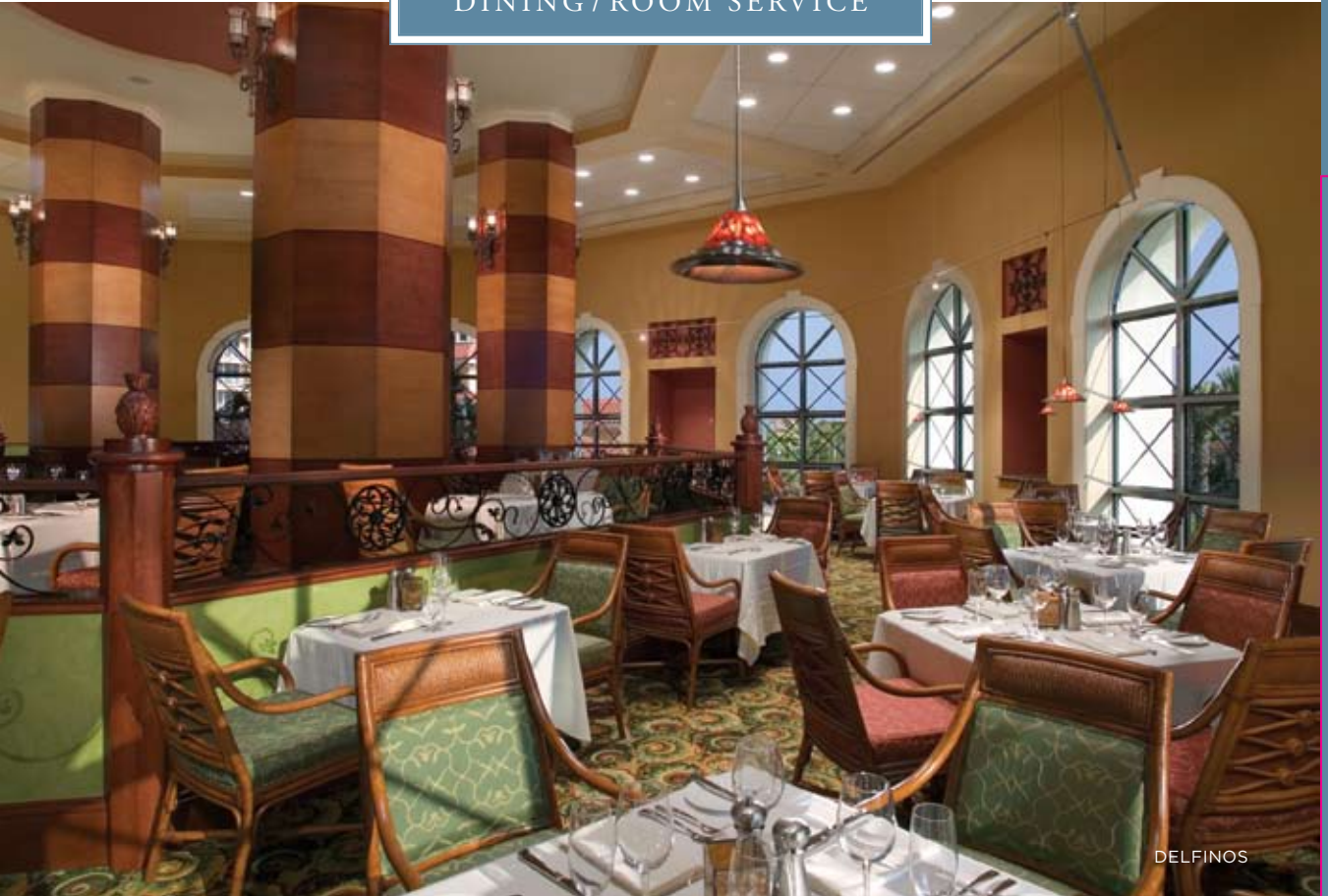

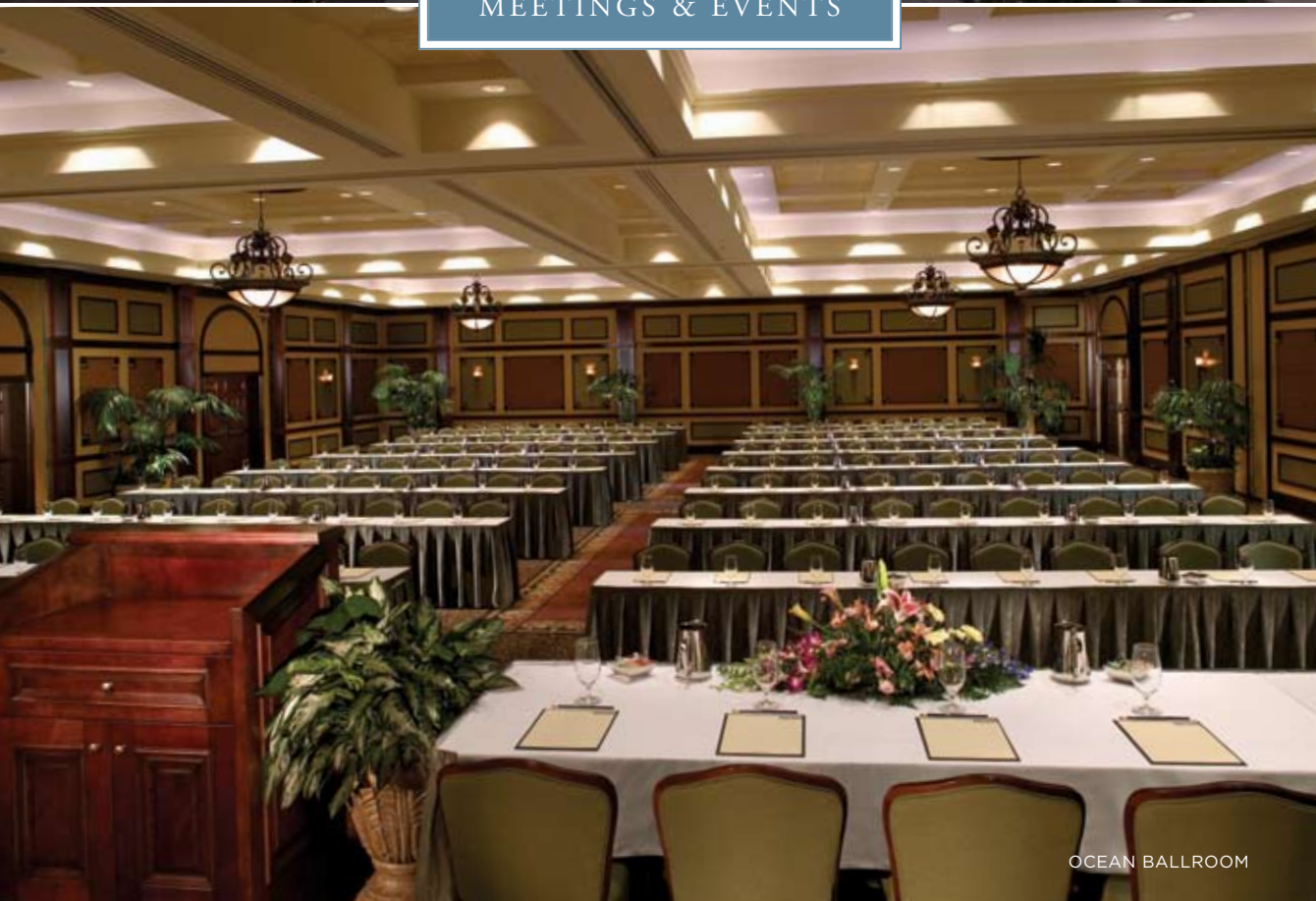

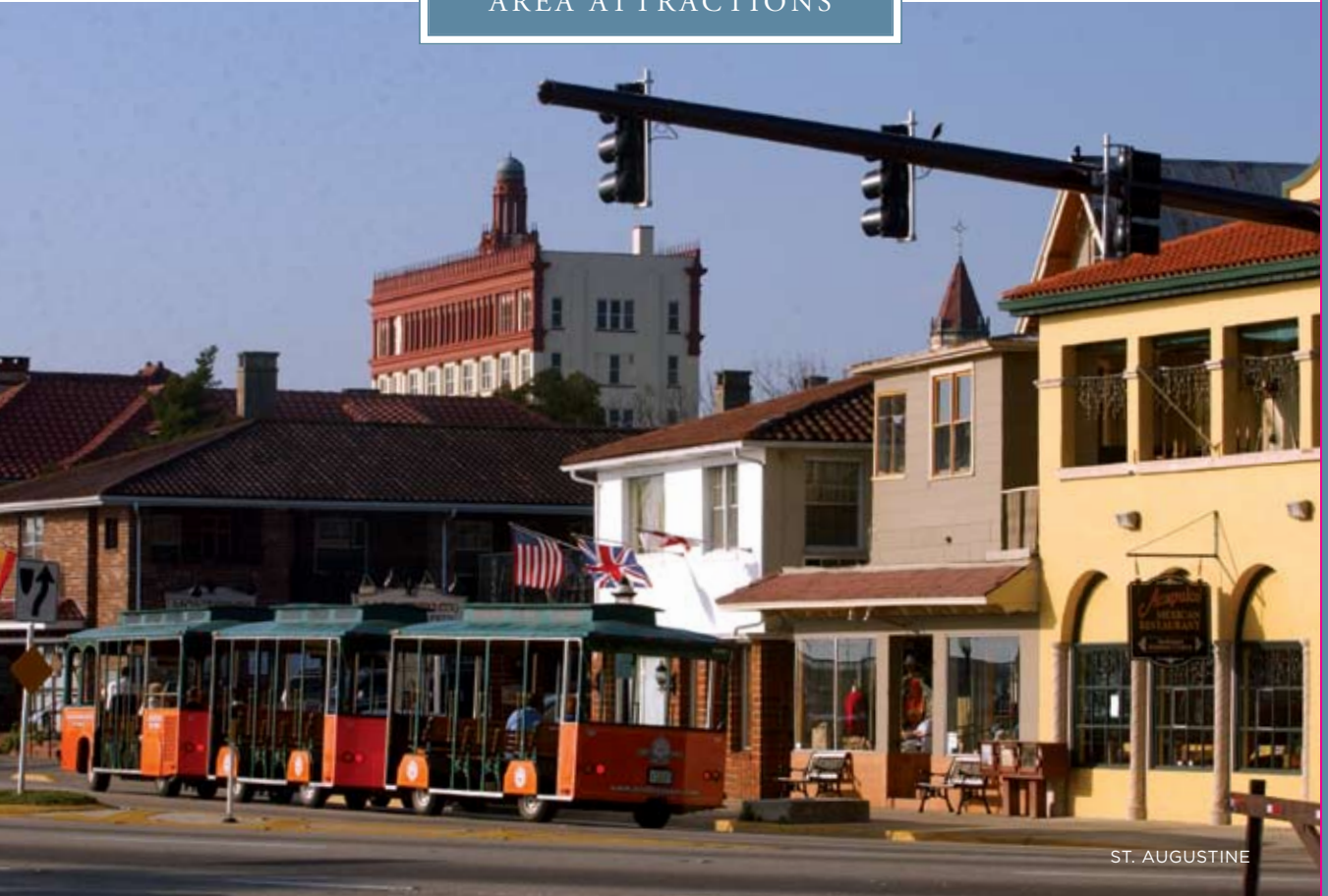

FLAGSHIP HARBOR

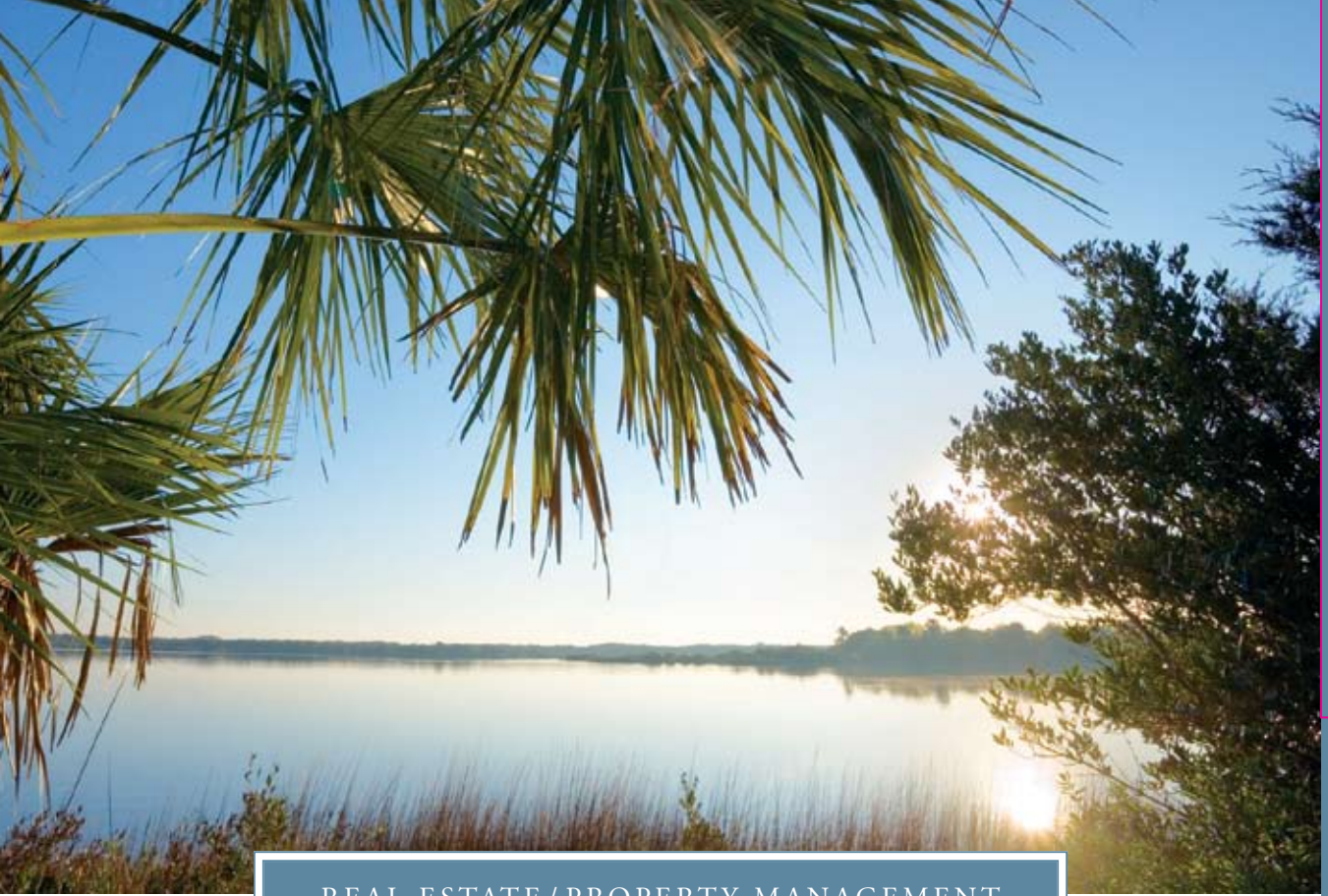

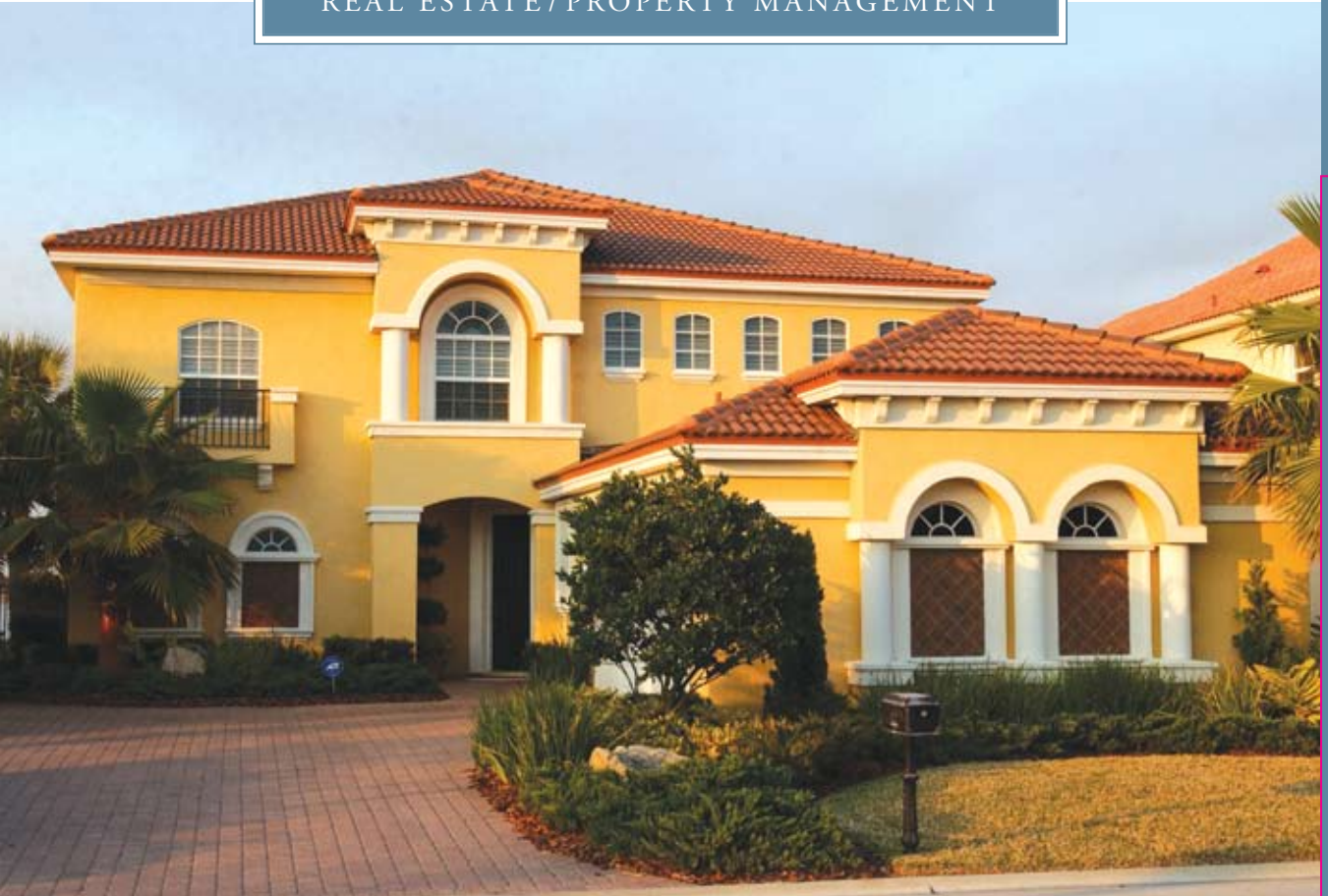

EXIT DRILLS IN THE HOME

People can survive even major fires in their homes if they are alerted to the fire in time and know what to do. In a recent NFPA survey, half the people responding said their family had a fire escape plan, but only 16 percent said they had practiced it. Survival Is Simple:

- Install smoke alarms and keep them in working order.
 - Make an escape plan and practice it.
- React immediately at the first sign of a fire.

PLAN YOUR ESCAPE

There's no time for planning during a fire emergency. Sit down with your family today and make a step-by-step plan for escaping a fire.

Draw a floor plan of your home, marking two ways out (including windows) of every room – especially sleeping areas. Discuss the escape routes with every member of your household.

Agree on a meeting place outside your home where every member of the household will gather after escaping a fire to wait for the fire department. This allows you to count heads and inform the fire department if anyone is missing or trapped inside the burning building.

IMPORTANT: Practice your escape plan at least twice a year. Have a fire drill in your home. Appoint someone to be monitor and have everyone participate. A fire drill is not a race. Get out quickly, but carefully.

Make your exit drill realistic. Pretend that some exits are blocked by fire and practice using alternative escape routes. Pretend that the lights are out and that some escape routes are filling with smoke.

BE PREPARED

Make sure everyone in the household can unlock all doors and windows quickly, even in the dark. Windows or doors with security bars need to be equipped with quick-release devices and everyone in the household should know how to use them.

If you live in an apartment building, use stairways to escape. Never use an elevator during a fire. It may stop between floors or take you to a floor where the fire is burning. Some high-rise buildings may have evacuation plans that require you to stay where you are and wait for the fire department.

If you live in a two-story house and you must escape from a second story window be sure there is a safe way to reach the ground. Make special arrangements for children, older adults, and people with disabilities. People who have difficulty moving should have a phone in their sleeping area and, if possible, should sleep on the ground floor.

Doors need to be tested before opening them. While kneeling or crouching at the door, reach up as high as you can and touch the door, the knob, and crack between the door and its frame with the back of your hand. If the door is warm, use another escape route. If the door is cool, open it with caution. Put your shoulder against the door and open it slowly. Be prepared to slam it shut if there is smoke or flame on the other side.

If you are trapped, close all doors between you and the fire. Stuff the cracks around the doors to keep out smoke. Wait at a window and signal for help with a light-colored cloth or a flashlight. Do not break out the window as you may need to close it. If there's a phone in the room, call the fire department and tell them exactly where you are.

GET OUT

In case of fire, don't stop for anything. Do not try to rescue possessions or pets. Leave the building, go directly to your meeting place, and then call the fire department from a neighbor's phone, a portable phone, or an alarm box. Every member of your household should know how to call the fire department.

Crawl low under smoke. Smoke contains deadly gases, and heat rises. During a fire, cleaner air will be near the floor. If you encounter smoke when using your primary exit, use an alternate escape route. If you must exit through smoke, crawl on your hands and knees, keeping your head 12 to 24 inches (30 to 60 centimeters) above the floor.

...AND STAY OUT

Once you are out of your home, don't go back for any reason. If people are trapped, the firefighters have the best chance of rescuing them. The heat and smoke of a fire are overpowering. Only firefighters have the training, experience, and protective equipment needed to enter burning buildings.

PLAY IT SAFE

More than half of all fatal home fires happen at night while people are asleep. Smoke alarms sound an alarm when they sense smoke from a fire, alerting people before they are trapped or overcome by smoke. With smoke alarms, your risk of dying in a home fire is cut nearly in half. Install smoke alarms outside every sleeping area and on every level of your home, including the basement. Follow installation instructions carefully and test smoke alarms monthly. Change all smoke alarm batteries at least once a year. If your alarm is more than 10 years old, replace it. For complete home protection, consider installing an automatic fire sprinkler system.

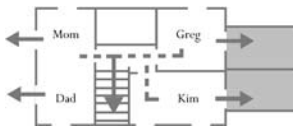

Planning Your Escape

The Floor Plan

- Draw an outline of your home or apartment. Make a drawing for each floor where people sleep. Dimensions don't need to be exact.
- Now add each bedroom and label it. Show important details: stairs, hallways, roofs that could be used as a fire escape.
- Choose a family meeting place and show it on the plan.



Inspection Time!

- Check each bedroom for the best window or door for an emergency escape.
- Test windows - make sure they open easily and are large enough and low enough. Can the children open them?
- While you're at it, check your smoke detector. If you don't have one, get one.

Finish Your Escape Plan.

- Use blue or black arrows to show the normal way out, such as the stairs or hall.
- Use different colored arrows to show emergency exits in case fire blocks your normal route.

Some tips:

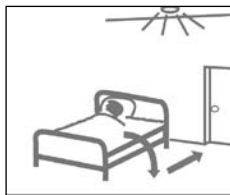
- Be sure everyone has a second way out.
- Escape ladders may be necessary.
- Any security devices should open easily. In a fire you might not be able to find a key.
- Rearrange bedrooms, if necessary, to provide easier escape for children, elderly or disabled.
- Never use elevators if there's a fire.

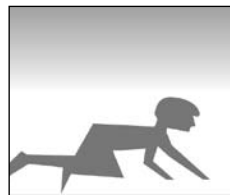
The Family Meeting

Discuss your plan and these procedures with your family:

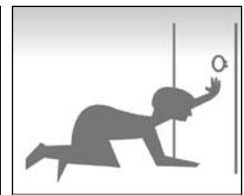
- 1 Always sleep with bedroom doors closed. This will keep heat and smoke out for a short time - the few extra minutes you may need to escape.
- 2 Find a way for everyone to sound a family fire alarm. Blow a whistle, pound on walls, yell, etc.
- 3 In a fire, seconds count. Don't waste time dressing or looking for valuables or pets. As much as they may mean to you, your life is more important.
- 4 Roll out of bed. Stay low. Just one breath of smoke or hot gases can kill you.
- 5 Feel the door. If the door or doorknob is hot, don't open it! Instead, use your second way out.
- 6 Once outside, go to your family meeting place. Check to see if everyone is safe. Once you're out, stay out!
- 7 Call the fire department from a neighbor's house. If you use a street alarm box, wait there to direct the fire department to the fire location.

The Drill

- 1 Begin with everyone in his or her bed.
- 2 Sound the alarm. Press the smoke detector test button. Yell FIRE! or use some other signal.
- 3 Everyone should roll out of bed, stay low and feel the door for heat. First time: use the normal exit. Brace your shoulder against the door and open it slowly, ready to shut it quickly if there is heat or smoke. Second time: pretend doors are hot. Everyone must use the second way out.
- 4 Gather at meeting place and check that everyone is out.
- 5 Appoint someone to simulate calling the fire department.
- 6 Get together to talk about the drill. Make changes to the plan if necessary and rehearse them.
- 7 Hold a family escape drill every few months - at least twice a year. The more you practice, the better you will be able to act quickly and automatically in a fire emergency.

BOIL WATER NOTICE



Department of Business and Professional Regulation DIVISION OF HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS

By Authority of Section 381.006 and 403.855-857, Florida
These procedures must be observed while a "BOIL WATER NOTICE" is in effect

TAP WATER

- Do not serve water from faucets until local health authorities advise the water is safe for consumption. Use only bottled water from an approved source and/or boiled tap water. **BOIL WATER AT A ROLLING BOIL FOR ONE MINUTE** to kill infectious organisms.
- An alternative method for areas without power is to mix 8 drops (1/8 teaspoon) of unscented household bleach per gallon of water and allow to stand for 30 minutes. If the water is cloudy in appearance, add 16 drops (1/4 teaspoon) and let stand for 30 minutes. (Water will NOT be toxic, but may have a chlorine order and taste.) Note: Using bleach will not kill parasites that may be present, however boiling will kill parasites.

ICE, ICE-MAKING, BEVERAGE & WATER VENDING

- Ice bagged or made prior to the issuance of the boil water notice may be used.
- Ice produced in ice machines after the issuance of a boil water notice must be discarded and machines not restarted until the water supply is deemed safe by local health authority. Sanitize the interior of the ice machine, ice trays and built-in ice-makers with two teaspoons (100+ ppm) of household bleach in one gallon of water prior to restarting the ice machine or ice-maker.
- Disconnect or turn off water vending machines, drinking fountains, misters, ice-making units and soda machines to prevent their use.
- Filters in water lines should be replaced if the water supplier detected bacteria in the water samples or if debris accumulation is observed in the filter(s). Information regarding the presence of bacteria will be provided by your water supplier or through the news media.

HAND WASHING

- Do not use tap water for hand washing. Use only bottled water from an approved source and/or boiled (and safely cooled) tap water. After proper hand washing, use a sanitizing solution on the hands. This may be accomplished by using a commercial hand sanitizing lotion that requires no rinse or a chlorine bleach solution of two teaspoons of household bleach in one gallon of water. Single-use gloves may be used to provide additional protection after proper hand washing.
- No bare hand contact with ready-to-eat food is allowed while boil water notice is in effect.

COOKING & CLEANING

- Food equipment, utensils and food-contact surfaces that must be cleaned in place (does not fit into a three-compartment sink), may be cleaned with steam with no additives, a sanitizing mix of bottled or boiled water and bleach (50-100 ppm) or other approved sanitizing solution.
- Do not use tap water for food processing or food preparation until the "BOIL WATER NOTICE" is lifted by local authorities. Use only bottled water from an approved source and/or boiled tap water for these purposes.

DISHWASHING/WAREWASHING

- Manually wash, rinse and sanitize dishes, food equipment and utensils with bottled water from an approved source and/or boiled tap water utilizing a three-compartment sink in the approved manner. Use single-service articles when possible.
- Mechanical dishwashers may be used **ONLY** to remove food residue and debris, if followed by a manual wash, rinse and sanitization as described above.

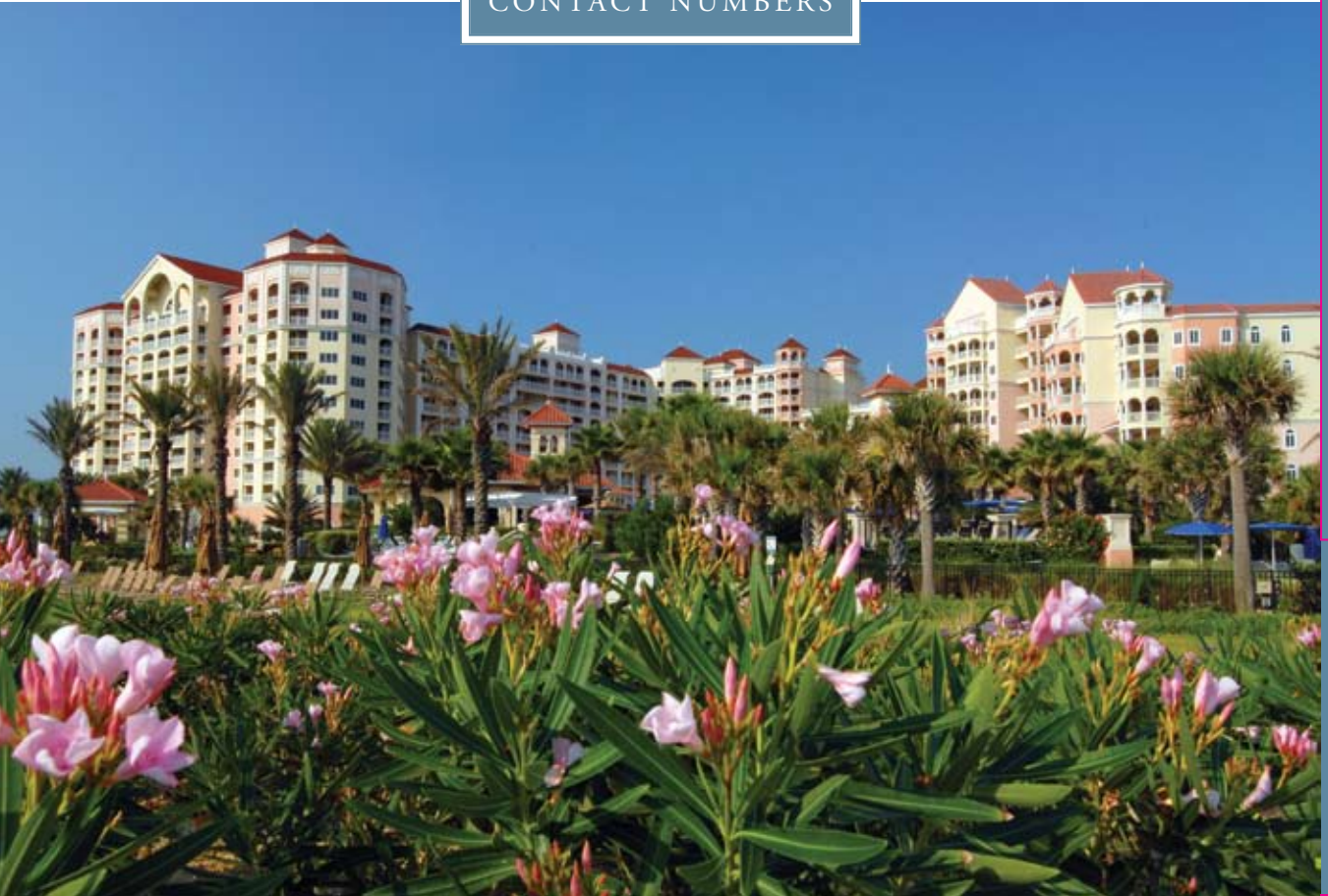
RESCINDING THE BOIL WATER NOTICE

- You will be advised by the local Health Department directly or through the news media when a "BOIL WATER NOTICE" been rescinded (lifted). **AFTER** the "BOIL WATER NOTICE" is lifted, allow water to run for five minutes at each tap to flush the lines with safe water. Remember to include misters, drinking fountains, ice makers (discard the first binful), soda machines, etc., when flushing the lines.
